# The Big Question

*Hold up the Big Question sign for all the children to see,  
and say:*

The Big Question we are investigating today is  
Big Question Number 5:

**Can You Tell Me What God Made?**  
and the Answer is:  
**God Made All Things Good!**

## Meaning:

Did you ever wonder where everything in this world came from? All of the plants, animals and insects...the fish and birds...the sun, moon, stars and planets...the tall mountains and the beautiful oceans...the people here around us and the angels up in heaven? Did they just get here on their own? No, they did not! God made them. And when God made them, He made them good—perfect and without sin. He made them just right for His good plan for the world.

What was God's good plan for the world? He planned for everything He made to show us what He's like so we could know delight in how wonderful He is.



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## **This Unit's Bible Truths**

"God made all things good" is a good beginning, but there's so more to learn. So it's time for us to dig down even deeper for more answers to our Big Question about God. We're going to be learning TWO Bible truths that all tell us more about the good things that God made.

Who would like to hand me the picture with our two Bible truths on it? It's in the Big Question Box/Briefcase." Choose a child to get it and hand it to you, then hold it up and show them the pictures of the two truths they will be learning.

After everyone has had a good look, say...

"Ok, now let's look at our Bible Truth Clue sign and see if we can figure out which of these two truths we will be learning about today. Who would like to get it out of the Big Question Briefcase for me?"

*Choose a child to open the briefcase, take out the Bible Truth Clue sign and hand it to you.*



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# Revealing the Bible Truth We Are Learning

*Hold up the front side for the children to see. Cover up the answer, written along the bottom, and say:*

**"Can You Tell Me What God Made?  
God Made All Things Good!  
He Made Everything in Heaven and ????"**

We're missing one word. Here's the hint to what the missing word is. It says: "What is the name of the world we live in? It starts with an "e" and it rhymes with "birth."

Can you guess? It's "earth."

So the Bible Truth we are learning today is:

*(uncover answer from bottom of sign, show it to them and say:)*

**"Can You Tell Me What God Made?  
God Made All Things Good!  
He Made Everything in Heaven and Earth!"**

And here is what this Bible Truth means:

*(read the meaning off of the back of the sign, say:)*

God made everything in the beginning. He made the angels in heaven. He made the stars and moon we see at night, and the sun we see during the day. He made rivers and mountains and valleys. He made all the fish, the birds, the plants, bugs and the animals. He even made people. How did God make everything? He made it by His powerful word. He spoke, and everything was created. And it was all good—very good. There was no sin in any of it. It was all made just exactly right for God's good plans.

# Bible Truth | Bible Verse

*Remove the Bible Verse Picture from the "Bible" folder and hold it up for all the children to see, then say:*

Isaiah 44:24 tells us:

## **Isaiah 44:24, ESV**

"I am the LORD, who made all things, who alone stretched out the heavens, who spread out the earth by myself."

**Learn a Little:** "I am the LORD, who made all things."

## **What does that mean?**

Who made everything? The LORD did! And who helped Him? No one! He alone made the heavens and everything in them. He alone made the earth and everything in it. Isn't God amazing!

"Now it's time to do a bit more deep down investigating. Let's see what Detective Dan wants us to help him figure out. Would someone like to get it out for me?"

"We've said our Bible verse, now let's sing it!"








