
Big Question 13, Bible Truth 2 Storyboard Background Pictures Key (BG)

Put these pictures in place on your storyboard BEFORE you tell your story.



Note about felt pieces:

These are best made to size when you put the other storyboard pieces on your board, since board sizes vary.

Note about the Jordan River:

While most felt pieces are one, simple, large piece, the Jordan River is different. To create the river parting, you want to use two pieces of blue felt. Glue down the ends of the blue felt to the one-piece beach piece. Leave the middle section open so you can peel back the river. Curl the river back and tack down with the pieces of velcro that is attached to the underside of the two Sea pieces near the middle. (This velcro will help keep the middle of the river in place and then makes holding back each side easy when you open it up.


